Objectives

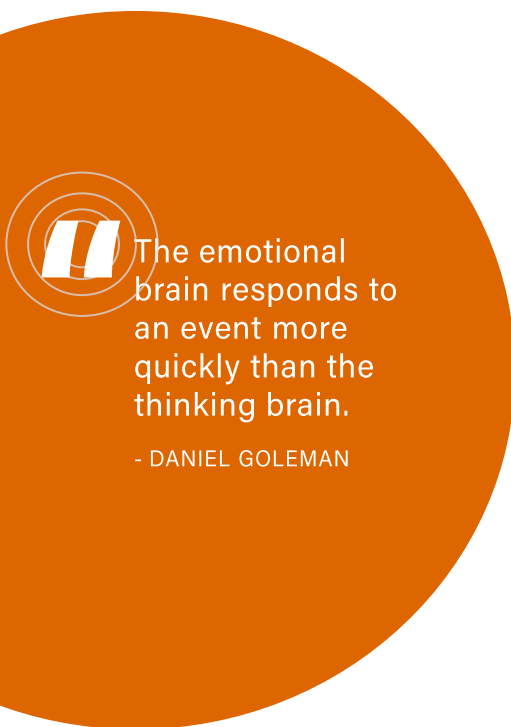
- To enable participants appreciate the practical applications of Emotional Intelligence (EI)

Methodology

All the sessions will be highly interactive in order to harness maximum learnings from everyone's experiences. Duration
