Focus



Research conducted by Harvard University, the Carnegie Foundation and Stanford Research Center, has concluded that 85% of job success comes from having well-developed soft skills and people skills, and only 15% of job success comes from technical skills and functional knowledge; the recent NASSCOM report endorses this fact by stating that 75% of the engineers are not employable since the focus is always on academics and theory.

Soft skills is a simple term for a complex set of personal qualities that help make an individual a positive and contributing member of any organization. It gives you that winning edge to move ahead in personal and professional lives. Soft skills are a vital part of the success of an individual or an organization.

Soft skills represent one of the fundamental attributes that the new knowledge-based economy demands of employers, employees and organizations. This program will equip all young managers to handle their role transition as they are expected to demonstrate a new set of competencies to perform well in their new role.

Adaptability is not just a soft skill, but a hard capability.

Methodology

The program is designed to facilitate experiential learning through interactive sessions,

which are organized around case studies, group activities, discussions, psychometric tools/assessments, exercises, experiential learning activities, practice sessions and films.

Duration
