

Focus



Today's business environment is best described as VUCA – Volatile, Uncertain, Complex and Ambiguous. VUCA is quite simply the expression of the fact that the rate of change is outpacing our ability to adapt. Structured, prescriptive readymade solutions cannot be offered for the problems faced by the organizations in the today's world as they are unique, multifaceted and complex. The managers have to develop ability to identify the real reasons for the problems, think outside the box for the solutions and also create the climate conducive for creativity, innovation and experimentation in the organization to enhance critical thinking abilities in the employees.

Managerial decision making in general is complicated and confusing. The progress of an organization can be profoundly affected by what a manager decides. Further, the decision stages, steps, platforms and phases are the important factors of the managerial decision-making process. Therefore, there is a need to train the managers so as to enable them to make effective decisions for their organizations based on agility in decision making, critical thinking, adaptable learning, people orientation and responsiveness to change.



The program blends creativity and problem solving in a comprehensive approach to problem solving and decision-making process. It aims at helping the participants in identifying the root cause of the problems, think creatively to find solutions and take optimal decisions to solve problems.
